Grand Pavois Organisation

Organizing each year since 1973, the International in-water boat show, the Grand Pavois. The association Grand Pavois (1901 French registration about associations) widened its acctivities in 1998.

In 1999, the association created a new events department named GPO - Grand Pavois Organisation - It was entrusted with the organisation of six editions of La Charente-Maritime/Bahia Transat 6,50, from 2001 to 2011.

At the same time, GPO took over the organisation of many ocean racing events: the stopovers for the Volvo Ocean Race and the Global Challenge, the departure

Village for the Solitaire du Figaro, the Défi Atlantique, the Grand Prix de France de Formule 1 Motonautique, the stopovers for the Clipper Race, the organisation of the naming and tour of Maud Fontenoy's L'Oréal Paris, the departure and arrival of the Velux 5 Oceans, the naming of François Gabart's 60-foot Imoca Macif and Yannick Bestaven's Class40 Le Conservateur, etc.

The know-how of Grand Pavois, an international inwater boat show, is exported. Between 2009 and 2011, GPO was in charge of the commercial development of the China Shenzhen International Boat Show (China), which became the leading Chinese in-water show after just a few editions. In 2013, Aix-Marseilles Metropolis also entrusted GPO with the organisation of Les Nauticales boat show in La Ciotat (4th French show) until 2021.

Another event created by GPO, the Rallye des Iles du Soleil which will set out at the end of October 2022 from La Palma (Canary Islands) for Marie-Galante in Guadeloupe for the 4th year running.

GPO also works on several other water sport projects to highlight and demonstrate the quality of its know-how that is already well-known and widely recognised.

A MAJOR NAUTICAL EVENT IN THE TOP 5 OF IN-WATER SHOWS

The Grand Pavois La Rochelle positions itself as one of the leading shows in the water sports sector with 800 international brands, 750 boats on show, more than 110 previews and new products, and 80 000 visitors expected each year. Held at the end of September, it is THE event for gauging the health of the French and European water sports sector for the coming year... An event that has become a must over the years!

On an international level, the Grand Pavois La Rochelle is one of the Top 5 international in-water boat shows with 300 bateaux exhibited, many of which are available to test. On a national level, the Grand Pavois La Rochelle remains a major event for many enthusiasts and the leading water sports event on the Atlantic facade with regions (Brittany, Pays de Loire and Nouvelle-Aquitaine) that are particularly dynamic in the water sports sector together generating almost half of the French turnover and the national workforce in the sector.

Today, the Grand Pavois La Rochelle is one of the leading economic events in the Nouvelle-Aquitaine Region. A platform for players from the water sports sector and sailing enthusiasts, over its 49 editions the Grand Pavois La Rochelle has become a key partner of the Nouvelle-Aquitaine Region, the Charente-Maritime department, the municipality of La Rochelle and its Communauté d'Agglomération.

A regional sector, 32% of which is concentrated in Gironde (Bordeaux and the Bassin d'Arcachon) and 55% of which in Charente-Maritime (La Rochelle and Rochefort), with a total of 1,200 establishments working in the water sports and sailing sector and 9,600 employees. First region in France in terms of the number of companies with 26%, **the Nouvelle-Aquitaine Region** is ahead of Brittany (25%), the Pays de Loire (18%) and the PACA region (12%). In terms of turnover and workforce, the Nouvelle-Aquitaine Region, with 19.5% of the national turnover and

22.4% of the workforce, lies in second place behind the PACA region (22.4% of the national turnover and 24.3% of the workforce).

With 460 km of coastline, 2,600 km of waterways, its 56 marinas offering 10,000 mooring places, and four islands, **Charente-Maritime** has displayed its wish to develop and support the water sports sector for many years alongside the Grand Pavois La Rochelle and Grand Pavois Organisation.

The water sports sector in La Rochelle and its Communauté d'Agglomération (CDA) in figures: 310 enterprises and professionals, 1,500 units leaving the La Rochelle's shipyards every year, 25 architect, design and engineering firms, 2,000 direct and indirect jobs, 46 qualifying and recognised training courses, 4,500 mooring places at Port des Minimes and 120 water sport events.

An event with strong values!

Even though the Grand Pavois La Rochelle changes each year to adapt to the needs of the profession and its dedicated visitors, the DNA of this show created in 1973 remains and offers exceptional value for money in the world of international shows, the opportunity of trials and outings at sea, pontoons and quaysides where you will find true enthusiasts and, above all, an event widely recognised as being very welcoming in a region that has always been focused on the sea.




GREECE 2021 GUEST OF HONOUR

YANNICK BESTAVEN PATRON OF THE GRAND PAVOIS LA ROCHELLE

Yannick Bestaven, the magnificent winner of the renewable energies (sun, wind, water, etc..) to produce 2020/21 Vendée Globe on Maître CoQ IV, will be the patron of the 40th edition of the Grand Pavois La Rochelle. Yannick, the winner of an exemplary solo round-the-world race without any stopovers or any assistance, completed his circumnavigation in 80 days, 03 hours, 44 minutes and 46 seconds.



Yannick is a loyal and habitual visitor to the La Rochelle international in-water boat show. An essential event in the water sports calendar which he has attended as a competitor, as an exhibitor with his company Watt&Sea, and also as someone who loves the sea, boats and great stories.

A look back...

In competitive terms, Yannick has a packed list of ocean-racing prizes with victories in Imoca 60, including the 2020/21 Vendée Globe, Mini 6.50 with La Transat 6.50 Charente-Maritime/Bahia 2001 (editor's note, Mini Transat), not to mention a double victory in the Transat Jacques Vabre in Class40 in 2011 and 2015. Remember that at the start of his 2008 Vendée Globe, which sadly ended prematurely, on the former "Aquitaine Innovations" owned by his friend Yves Parlier, Yannick took up the challenge of using only

the electricity needed for the vessel's proper functioning. It was a first that led to the creation of the company Watt&Sea in 2009 and the concept of the hydro-generator which Yannick and Matthieu Michou designed, manufactured and marketed. The aim was to enable racing and leisure boats to supply their own electricity to meet their on-board energy needs. A feat he succeeded since Watt&Sea hydrogenerators have revolutionised electricity management, minimising dependency on combustion engines. A true revolution for long-distance yachts and racing boats!

2001, a look back at a long history with Grand Pavois Organisation!

A look back... 2001 will remain a memorable year in more respects than one for Yannick and Grand Pavois Organisation. Thar GPO (editor's note, for Grand Pavois Organisation) organised its at first edition of La Transat 6.50 Charente-Maritime/Bahia (namely the Mini Transat, the first one to depart from La Rochelle on its way to Brazil via Puerto Calero in the Canary Islands), Yannick built his Mini 6.50 prototype with his own hands, the same as Arnaud Boissières who also built his one alongside him. Both of them set sail on their prototypes flying the colours of "Aquarelle.com", both built according to Magnen-Nivelt plans. At the helm of the Mini 6.50 number 304, Yannick completed the route in 30 days, 00 hours and 23 minutes, winning the two stages and also the first edition of this Transat 6.50 Charente-Maritime/Bahia organised by GPO. Alongside him, Arnaud came 3rd at the helm of number 303. For the record, the name of Yannick's Mini 6.50 was Satanas, while Arnaud's was Diabolo... What a surprise!

HERITAGE AND TRADITION SPACE PAST, PRESENT AND... FUTURE!

Vintage, classical and traditional boats, Historical boats from Nouvelle-Aquitaine will be on show at the Grand Pavois La Rochelle 2021!

Moored at a pontoon in the heart of the show, a sample of heritage boats will be presented including about a dozen listed vessels from among the 115 protected boats in the Nouvelle-Aquitaine Region. "Lasses" and oyster and mussel fishing sloops take pride of place alongside yachts and service boats. The buoy layer "Clapotis" will celebrate its 101st birthday!

All are invited to meet the dedicated owners and



visit and chat about these stunning vessels which continue to sail after being restored with great passion!

Dauphin Vert, Clapotis, Vagaluna, Colomba, La Flèche, Notre Dame de la Clarté, Talion, Petit Salé, le Boucholeur, Duperré will all be present in-water.

The emblematic sailing boat **Damien**, which Grand Pavois La Rochelle has accompanied since 2012, completely restored by the team led by the Friends of the Maritime Museum, will also be there!

Also, in this space, three unusual boats will be present with Sinbad (1950) for Esprit de Velox which will present its pioneering research, innovation and mediation programme combining an interdisciplinary and responsible approach to the ocean based on three main lines: the design of a bio-inspired energy-independent vessel with no operational environmental impact; the sharing of knowledge and the infusion of a culture of the Earth system. Esprit de Velox is an Ocean Decade contribution by the United Nations.

Pordin Nancq (Carter 37 from 1974) for the Passe Coque Association. The Passe-Coque association, created in 2019 in Morbihan works simply on saving and restoring boats which have been abandoned or which are destined for deconstruction. A concrete vision of the idea and concept of the renovation of boats. Meeting with the Member of Parliament for Morbihan Jimmy Pahun on Thursday 30 September. Not to mention Bakéa, an exceptional small versatile neo-classical cruiser hosted in partnership with Voile Magazine. The idea is that this one-off attracts a boatyard interested in creating its offspring...

LA PLAGE... YOUR FEET IN THE SAND BOARD SPORTS AND DINGHY SAILING

Did you know that the Grand Pavois La Rochelle is one of the only shows in the world to have its feet in the sand? Since 2000, the show has presented all types of water sports (dinghy sailing, kayaking, board sports, etc.) at La Plage located on Minimes Beach.

TRIALS AND TRY-OUTS FOR YOUNG AND OLD ALIKE!

Two basins will be set up for trials and



introductory experiences in SUP, dinghy sailing, kayaking, and more. Aunique opportunity for visitors to try the different activities

proposed. Every year, more than 1,500 trials take place in the basins as well as at sea over the six days of the show. This year, Tribord will be present at La Plage with water sports equipment available to try, Birdy Fish with its monohull dinghy, many board sport and dinghy sailing brands, such as Starboard and iQFoil (future Olympic windsurf), Tahé Outdoors, etc., not to mention a Vintage experience with La Planche à Voile à la Papa and its "World Championship".

A COMPLETELY FOIL YEAR WITH THREE KEY EVENTS DURING THE WEEKEND!

The National ETF 26 (7.80 metre foil catamaran). We can announce the presence of Billy Besson (SailGP, Nacra 17 World Champion, Rio Olympic Games, Sailor of the Year in 2015, etc.), Yvan Bourgnon (winner of the Mini Transat and Transat



Jacques Vabre, solo round-theworld race in a racing catamaran, Seacleaners project, etc.), Jean-Christophe

Mourniac (Tornado World Silver Medallist, etc.), Charles Dorange (3 times ISAF Youth World champion), and more. A unique opportunity to admire these catamarans which fly over the water and race neck-and-neck at (very) high speeds! Organised by La Rochelle Nautique.

Introduced to the show in 2018, this year the autumn National Windfoil will bring together 120 participants. The Fishing Space and Grand Pavois Fishing, created in 2008, has become a true platform for exchanges and discoveries between enthusiasts, visitors, brands accompanied by their competitors and pro staff. It features an activities platform, demonstration basins, a Fishing Village with exhibitors, a fishing boat gallery, not to mention the Grand Pavois Fishing Marina where sea trials are available every day from 10 am to 7 pm.

TEST NEW PRODUCTS AT SEA AND FOLLOW COURSES ON-BOARD!

Unique: the chance for visitors to test the boats, engines and equipment at sea. The wish? To allow brands the chance to benefit from the presence of their pro-staff and enjoy the opportunity to have perfectly equipped units tested at sea. A great moment of sharing for all enthusiasts...

Another asset of this in-water space is the chance to follow courses on embedded electronics and discover new equipment in action. Nothing could



be more magical for many amateurs than setting out to sea accompanied by pro-staff in order to learn and discover how sounders and other embedded cartography works.

A NO-KILL SEA FISHING CONTEST!

Grand Pavois Fishing has joined the ranks of the leading national no-bait sea bass fishing contests. Reserved solely for brands, this event will take place on Saturday and Sunday morning (8.00 am to 1.00 pm). A unique highlight since Grand Pavois La Rochelle is the only in-water boat show to offer such a sea fishing contest!

RECORD-MORE THAN 30 CREWS EXPECTED.

No need to say that this edition of Grand Pavois Fishing will be exceptional! More than 30 brand teams are expected for this 2021 edition (27 in 2019!) including several new brands. Note that among the competitors and other pro-staff, Christophe Coutanceau (Michelin 3-star chef) will exceptionally be present. A dedicated angler, he also wanted to take advantage of the opportunity to

promote sustainable gastronomy and seasonal fish consumption and to continue to teach better consumption behaviour. A



message which the Fishing Space and Grand Pavois Fishing wants to convey every year!

There are also new partnerships at the Fishing Space and Grand Pavois Fishing with Suzuki Marine which becomes a major partner alongside April Marine and 4Water. A strong commitment by the outboard engine brand which wants to promote its approach and its product range. Amiaud/Seanox also becomes a technical partner for the event by offering a net with specific types of mesh to each Grand Pavois Fishing crew so as to protect the fish and ensure that they can be returned to the water. Decathlon Pêche La Rochelle/Puilboreau also becomes a clothing partner for the Space.

ECO-RESPONSIBLEGRAND PAVOIS LA ROCHELLE!

If, today, CSR (Corporate Social Responsibility) is a notion that concerns all companies, the Grand Pavois La Rochelle show goes even further and Grand Pavois Organisation (GPO) is setting up every day eco-responsible measures, especially for its Grand Pavois La Rochelle event: the

organisation, its service providers, exhibitors, visitors, etc.



In its internal practices, GPO has always been sensitive to a systematic method of responsible purchases for all its events and the Grand Pavois La Rochelle was the first boat show to set up the

treatment of its waste – *Grand Pavois Bleu* – more than 15 years ago: installation of selective sorting bins during assembly and dismantling, installation of recycling bins (blue and yellow) to encourage selective sorting by visitors, recycling of banners and flags by local associations, reuse of unused neck straps by associations, recycling of all paper media, reuse of carpets for other GPO events or by local associations, etc.

GPO is continuing to develop new environmental measures - in the frame of the Grand Pavois La Rochelle show - to meet the major common goal of preserving the environment.

Several events "within the event" will be held during the 2021 edition of the Grand Pavois La Rochelle including, among other things, the setting up of a partnership with EDF (historic energy supplier in France) on the theme of "Eco-design and renewable energies" with a space called "Port of the future" where solutions for our ports of the future, and boats powered by renewable energies (electricity, hydrogen, water, etc.) will be exhibited.

Still with EDF, start-ups offering eco-responsible water sport projects will be presented to the public, the media and the water sport professionals present Finally, via its **Grand Pavois La Rochelle event, GPO is adhering to the La Rochelle Charter of Eco-Responsible events.**



HIGHLIGHTS OF THE SHOW



The Grand Pavois La Rochelle is focusing on the theme of "Sustainable Sailing and the Port of the future with EDF". Initiated in 2019, during the show, this partnership aims to present the new solutions that will be on the market in the future. As a stakeholder in the energy

transition, EDF defends and encourages eco-design and offers companies the chance to adapt their socio-economic model with the addition of new functions and the study of new uses. In the world of water sports, the move to electric is still underexploited despite a major development potential. The advantages of it are clear: less air and water pollution, less noise, vibrations, reduced costs, government subsidies, etc. The electric market in water sports currently represents about 1% of

the production of boatyards.



Based on this observation, EDF and Grand Pavois La Rochelle have set up a number of actions at the show:

- A Sustainable Innovations space devoted to companies working on innovative projects for the water sports sector will be available this year.

Discover: **Beyond the Sea**, boats towed by kite; **ADV Propulse**, biometric propulsion that allows the tiller to be removed and speeds three times greater; **Genevos - Océan Lab** presented by the sailor Phil Sharp, hydrogen fuel battery technology used for electric propulsion, **Bird-E marine**: electrical foil motorcycle etc.

- An "electric port of the future" with EDF recharging stations will be presented exclusively with a demonstration of electric boats. These include the Passeur de La Rochelle (an electric sea bus managed by the RTCR), EM Marine, Bird e-Marine, ADV Propulse, etc. Visitors will be able to meet the exhibitors and obtain a more accurate idea of the advantages of the new motorisation solutions in terms of noise, smell, and the cost reduction offered by these new technologies. Remember that, from 1 January 2022, in marinas with a capacity of more than 100 mooring places, at least 1% of the quayside berths must be equipped with electric charging terminals and will be reserved for electric boats (Article L. 1521-4 / Amendment No.CD1086 of 7 May 2019).
- A thematic path at the show called "Sailing and ports of the future" will be proposed promoting exhibitors that offer solutions or innovations in terms of alternative energies. The aim is to raise awareness among new users and leisure sailors with regard to their uses. To find them at the show, specific signposting will be installed in front of the stands to identify them. They will also be listed in the digital version of the official catalogue and on the show's website.
